WASTE ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT REGULATIONS 2006

DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL AS AN APPROVED AUTHORISED TREATMENT FACILITY (AATF).

We have considered your application and grant approval to **MDJ Light Brothers (SP) Ltd** to operate an AATF at the following sites:

This approval requires that you comply with the conditions of approval for each site listed (a copy of the conditions is attached). Your approval will allow you to issue evidence notes for Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) which is received at these sites and which is subsequently re-used, treated, recovered and/or recycled.

You can only issue Evidence notes in the following circumstances:

- Where the WEEE is received by you and is subsequently re-used as a whole appliance (frequently regarded as refurbishment)
- Where the WEEE is treated by you or another ATF and subsequently recovered or recycled by a UK recovery/recycling site(s)
- Where the WEEE is treated by you or another ATF and the resulting WEEE materials are exported by an Approved Exporter

This approval does not replace any other environmental authorisation(s) that you may have for the site(s). You must continue to comply with these and other relevant legislation. **You must ensure that you have a Environmental Permit, a Paragraph 40 exemption or a Paragraph 41 exemption (where applicable) that allows you to treat WEEE. You must treat the WEEE according to Best Available Treatment, Recovery & Recycling Techniques (BATRRT).** Guidance on these requirements can be found on Defra's website at:



This approval is valid from 1 January 2009 until 31 December 2009 unless it is cancelled or suspended by us or is deemed to be cancelled under the Regulations (See attached list of reasons for cancellation). This approval applies only to the named operator for the named site(s). You must notify us immediately in writing of any changes to the details submitted with your original application. (Please note, if the ownership or occupancy of the site changes you will have to make a new application for approval of the site).

AATFs wishing to be approved for the next compliance period (1 January – 31 December 2010) and to have their approval run concurrently, should apply to the Environment Agency using the relevant application forms before 30 September 2009.
